# **Green Card S/T Bowie-Dick Test Card** BD 117 / BD 118

# Indications for Use

The Green Card S/T Bowie-Dick Test Card is designed for daily monitoring of pre-vacuum steam sterilizers operating at 134°C for 3.5 minutes with sub-atmospheric or trans-atmospheric cycles as defined in ISO 11140-4 to detect the presence of residual air.

## **Color Change**

The Green Card will change from purple to green when exposed to steam sterilization cycle with acceptable vacuum cycles.

#### Instructions for Use

The Bowie-Dick test is conducted each day in an empty sterilizer prior to processing any loads.

- 1. Run a warm up cycle with the Green Card Holder to properly heat the sterilizer.
- 2. Insert a Green Card in the holder with the purple indicator side facing up and the information label facing down.
- 3. Place the Green Card and holder on the bottom rack, nearest to the drain of the empty sterilizer.
- 4. Run the sterilizer for 3.5 minutes at 134°C. Note: Long drying phases may cause the indicator to turn brown in color.
- 5. While wearing heat resistant gloves, remove the Green Card and holder from the sterilizer.
- 6. Date the Green Card on the back, identify the sterilizer and save the card for file records.

## Interpretation

Examine the indicator upon removal from the sterilizer and record the results. If no significant amount of residual air is present, the indicator will show a uniform green color change. If the indicator shows a purple color in the center, this indicates the presence of residual air.

# Safety Precautions

CAUTION: the Green Card and holder will be hot and should be handled carefully to avoid thermal injury.

#### Storage

- Store at normal room temperature 10° 38°C and 10-70% R.H.
- Protect from moisture and excess humidity
- Store in the resealable bag provided

#### **Expiry Date**

The expiry date is printed on the product packaging. Do not use after expiration date listed on the packaging.

# LOT Number

A unique identification code, LOT, is printed on each indicator label and packaging labels.

# Interfering Substances or Conditions

There are no known interfering substances or conditions that could affect the intended use of the indicator or adversely affect the indicator performance.

## **Release of Toxic Substances**

The indicator releases no known toxic substances in sufficient quantities to cause either a health hazard, or a hazard to the intended properties of the product being sterilized before, during or after the sterilization process.

# **Declaration of Conformity**

The Green Card S/T Bowie-Dick Test Card indicator conforms to all applicable portions of ISO 11140-4 indicators for use in specific tests.
